



## Your University

### **Aim:**

The aim of 'Your University' is to get students to consider what factors will help determine which university they would choose to go to.

### **Year Range:**

Year 9 - 10

### **Number of Participants:**

20 - 40 (five per group)

### **Completion Time:**

30-50 minutes

### **Equipment:**

- ❖ flip chart paper (enough for one piece per group)
- ❖ flip chart pens (enough for a few coloured pens per group)
- ❖ blu-tak
- ❖ post-it notes to be used as voting slips

### **Instructions:**

Give each group a piece of flip chart paper and a number of flip chart pens. Get each group to design a poster advertising their ideal university. Tell the groups that they can design the poster any way, but it must include:

- the name of the university
- where it is located (anywhere in the world)
- five courses that the university offers

**Downloadable Resource.**

- five sports and societies clubs the university offers
- what facilities the university has to offer
- where you live

Once all of the groups have completed their posters then ask each group to present their's to the rest of the class. The rest of the class then has to vote (apply) using their voting slips for the best university. The group whose university gets the most amounts of votes wins.

**Conclusion:**

'Your university' should encourage the students to think about if they were going to university what would affect their decision. It would also hopefully get the students excited about the prospect of going to university and the opportunities it could provide.
